SNOWSPORTS FACILITIES & PROGRAMS

- Largest ski area east of the Rockies
- 2,820 feet - the most continuous in New England
- Maine's second highest peak at 4,237 feet; only lift-serviced above-treeline skiing in the East
- 1,417 foot base with the Sugarloaf Resort Village at the base
- 54 miles, 921 acres, 146 trails, and glades
- 23% beginner, 34% intermediate, 27% advanced, 16% expert
