From value priced Big S season passes, two terrain parks, a superpipe, and winter-tubing to Nordic skiing, rental season passes and lesson packages for all abilities, The Summit is a total choice, day-area destination. Now bigger and better than ever, The Summit expanded its terrain at the Summit East base area during the 2010-2011 winter season, installing two chairlifts, adding 65 acres and providing access to runs last accessible over 20 years ago. Additionally, Alpental is infamous as one of the most challenging ski areas in the country with widely-renowned backcountry terrain.
